 - 1. Title 1 \$30,000 (low income)
 - 2. Title 2 \$6,000 (teacher training)
 - 3. Title 4 \$10,000
 - 4. IDEA \$39,000 (special ed)
 - iii. Mr. Oguz showed the Utah Grants website to see these grants in more detail

 - v. Some funds used for summer school 2021, approx. 50 students attended, lots of positive feedback. Will continue for 2 more summers
 - e. BSTA Teacher Student Success Act Plan and Budget
 - i. Approx. \$54,000
 - ii. Recruit, retain, grow talent in professional teachers. (45% of fund)
 - iii. Salary and benefits for full time school counselor
 - f. Fall Festival – ideas and discussion
 - i. Only for students (not families), gear activities toward teenagers (ie: mobile escape room), food for purchase (parents donate food)
 - ii. Activity free, charge for food
 - iii. Student council will have activities for students to do while they wait for escape room.
 - iv. Location will probably be Building A, still TBD
 - v. Students may bring 1 age-appropriate friend
 - vi. Parents needed to help run activities, donate food
 - vii. Judy is still taking suggestions for activities (that teens would like)
