3. New Business (discussion)

- Mr Kablan reported the SAGE Results:
 - Overall results were good
 - Middle school science results have not yet been released
 - Math and Science went up
 - Discrepancy with 10th grade Language Arts that Beehive is working to correct
 - The state is changing all of the testing and Mr. Kablan has been training on this (RICE testing)
 - We will probably send links to parents to show them what is changing
- Mr Kablan talked about AP testing results
 - Our test results were good considering we were a first year program; we had a 50% pass rate overall, although results varied across the subjects
 - Tysa suggested the Step to the U program that is at Alta High school- Mr. Kablan said he would look into it

4. School land trust money

- We have a new science department which we are very excited about
 - All new teachers but 1, they are all new to the state as well
- Middle school science standards are new so there is still a lot to learn
- We need to fund a science department assistant because the STEM expo is a

large burden on the teachers

- Having a parent volunteer help the teachers has been really great in the past; it's for helping with tedious tasks like tracking kids projects

5. STEM Expo

- The Utah Association of Public Charter Schools and The National School Choice Week want to help partner with us on the STEM Expo
- STEM Expo happens to fall during the week of National school choice awareness
- They will take on some of the work such as advertising, reaching out to media, bringing in more charter schools
- Science department assistant will be able to help with coordination with Utah Association of Charter schools

6. Academic Intervention (AI) program

- Students with missing assignments or failing grades use their lunch time or SSR time to (~2 hrs per week) work with teachers to help them identify the issues they are facing and support them in building habits that allow them be successful.

7. New college class for seniors

- Started a new class called "College and career planning" for seniors to learn about their college applications and career choices
- Lots of materials are available from the state
