- Approval of Minutes from September 24, 2021
 - Audrey motioned to approve minutes, seconded by Judy. AIF approved 1:10pm
- Old Business
 - Parent involvement and volunteering opportunities:
 - Not at much traction that we had hoped – Megan is following up on parent survey
 - New building will need plenty of support and parent involvement
 - New facility update:
 - Shopko building 94,000 ft², 2nd floor has 23,000 ft² but we will not be using that right now
 - Adding elementary with separate entries and separate schedules
 - This building has been purchased as it was more sensible for our budget Possession on 12/2/2021
 - Complicated permitting and bonding process but much of it is approved and secured. Starting construction next week
 - Target date: July 15, 2022
 - Need to get enrollment up! Need about 400 more students with the addition of elementary. Radio ads, mailers, and signage are already being used
 - Outdoor space: 9.2 acres, grass soccer field, fenced elementary playground, 370+ parking spots
 - Indoor space: there will be a gym indoors, there will be a kitchen and a large cafeteria
 - Fall festival report:
 - Kids had fun with the escape room, there were about 3x more kids than expected.
 - Hoping to invite family next year as in previous years

- International Thanksgiving dinner update:
 - Fewer families bringing international meals
 - Lots of leftovers after school!
- STEM Expo
 - Jan 29 2022, hoping to be in-person this year
 - Fewer sponsors than we hoped but still optimistic
 - Next year, elementary and Kindergarten kids are welcome to participate as well.
- New Business
 - Student safety:
 - Successful fire drill in November.
 - Some bullying noticed @ Beehive, implementing a new Stand for Kind anti-bullying program.
 - Kick-off Bullying assembly Jan 5, 2022
 - Rewards for random acts of kindness
 - There will be a parent training available to stamp out bullying.
 - Beehive's elementary school and its new elementary school principal:
 - Lisa Ronnenkamp was a principal at a Davis school district school and is excited to come to Beehive. She has taught 3rd,4th,5th, and 6th grades.
 - New enrollments and community support:
 - Emphasize STEM and science at Beehive and encourage lots of growth with science.
